New Business

2024 Levee Fee Update.

Motion was made to award the 2025 season herbicide order to Arborchem Products, 941 Nixon Drive, Mechanicsburg, PA in the amount \$10,920.98. Four (4) quote requests were solicited and the Arborchem price was the lowest responsible quote submitted. This order supplements the Authority's existing inventory of herbicides.

Motion was made to table the vote for the proposed Occupancy License Agreement (OLA) No. 23-4 with Joe Amato Properties, 272 East End Centre, Wilkes-Barre, PA in support of its property A&A Self Storage, 1000 Exeter Avenue, Exeter, PA. Their request is to install and maintain a 24-foot wide asphalt driveway (approx. 450 sf) on the Authority owned Parcel No. 23E-1 identified as PIN #16-E11-00A-002.

The OLA Fee Schedule has remained unchanged since its adoption by the LCFPA Board on November 14, 2002. The Board requested the Executive Director to re-visit the fee schedule and provide the Board with a recommendation on updated rates.

The A&A Self Storage project in Exeter is "on hold" by Amato Properties while they update project costs. Once they are confident they will be moving forward with the project, they will be back in touch to further discuss a possible license agreement.

Motion was made to approve an "Agreement for the Grant of Perpetual Easement" between the LCFPA and the County of Luzerne, Luzerne County Courthouse, 200 N. River Street, Wilkes-Barre, PA. In support of the ARPA-approved project "Levee Maintenance Garage Expansion", the LCFPA is requesting a 1.88-acre perpetual easement on County-owned land that surrounds the existing levee maintenance garage located at 15 Camryn Way, Forty Fort. The identified County-owned land is PIN #21-F10-00A-08A and consists of approx. 95 acres.
